American Diabetes Association CAMP CAREFREE is located at Lion's Camp Pride off Middleton Road on Merrymeeting Lake in New Durham, New Hampshire. The camp opens onto a cove in the southeastern corner of the lake and is ringed by hills on three sides.

VISITING TIMES: Parents can talk with the staff on OPENING and CLOSING DAY. Visiting is not permitted during the actual camp session!

LETTERS: Please write letters frequently! Mail call is the major highlight of the camp day. We suggest that you write a letter and mail early to arrive on your child's first full day of camp.

ONE WAY E-MAILS: Go to the camp website (www.campcarefreekids.org) to send an email. Please be aware that there is a charge of forty cents (\$.40) per e-mail sent, which helps to cover our costs.

FORMS: Most requested forms are due by March 30. All remaining forms will have specific due dates listed on the form.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Please apply by March 30. You will be notified after your application and tax forms are received.

To receive financial aid:

- Send in the Financial Assistance Application (included below) by March 30, filled out to the best of your ability if your tax form is not ready.
- Send a copy of your **2015 or 2016** tax form (front page only) by April 30 (or once available). White out all social security numbers.
- You are responsible for paying the difference between the camper's tuition and the amount awarded. This payment is due by June 1, unless other arrangements have been made with the Camp Coordinator, Wendy Pack.
- **PLEASE NOTE: If your camper has received financial aid for two years (consecutively or not), you will not be given financial aid again this year. If you received financial aid for one year, we will only award you half of what you qualify for this year. This allows for other families who have not received financial aid the ability to receive it. Remember: our resources are limited. Thank you for your understanding.**

BED WETTING: PLEASE let us know before camp starts. The embarrassing aspects can be greatly minimized if the counselors are prepared to deal with the situation.

Please send the rubberized sheet as listed on the clothing list, and we'll take care of the rest!

LAUNDRY: We would like to remind you that there are NO laundry facilities for camper use.

RADIOS/ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Campers are NOT permitted to have electronic equipment at camp. Not only can this equipment be distracting, but it can easily be broken or lost. NOTE: includes (but is not limited to) hairdryers, CD players, MP3 Players, IPODs, hand held video games, video cameras, etc. Expensive cameras are discouraged.

CELL PHONES: Campers are NOT permitted to have cell phones in camp. Also please be aware when traveling to the camp that there is no cell phone reception on the property.

DEPARTURE TIME: **Saturday, August 5.** Plan to arrive between 9:30 and 11:00am per the check-out process as scheduled on Opening Day. All campers should be on their way home NO LATER than noon when camp officially closes. *****We respectfully ask that you DO NOT PLAN to have your child leave camp at an earlier day/time as this affects many, many others as well as your child. PLEASE PLAN FOR THIS PICK-UP TIME ONLY!!**
