FOR YOUTH WITH DIABETES IN THE HEART OF NEW ENGLAND

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW BEFORE APPLYING TO CAMP**

This year the ADA is utilizing the Active Network to facilitate camp registrations nationwide. After registering you will see that you have a dashboard that will include payments made or pending, as well as some of the supplemental forms that are needed for our camp. These features help us all to see where you are in the process of completing the paperwork and financial pieces so that your child is all set to come to camp this summer.

The payment options that are offered on the Active Network are listed below. NO initial payment is required at this time.

- Payment in full by credit card the day you apply
- Payment by installments set up on your credit card or by electronic checks. Payments are due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month with the final payment due on 5/15 and divided equally among the months.  
\*\*Choose this option if you want to be billed automatically.
- Manual payments. When you select this option, the payments due list shows up as above to provide a payment schedule for you. If you opt not to pay at a specific time, that amount will be evenly rolled into the remaining dates. It is then possible to wait until 5/15 or even 6/1 to pay the full amount or pay in between as well. Any financial aid, sponsorships, gifts or camperships will be applied when received and reduce the final amount accordingly. You can follow this in real time on your dashboard.  
\*\*Choose this option if you are applying for financial aid, do not want to be billed automatically, or you want to mail a check to the ADA.

After selecting your payment option, hit “complete”. You will receive a confirmation email with a link to your account. Once logged into your account, you can customize your payment plan, make a payment, and view your balance.

**FINANCIAL AID:** If you are requesting financial aid, you must upload a copy of the first page of your 2015 or 2016 1040/1040EZ forms (**please white-out social security numbers**) in your online account. Financial Aid is awarded on a first come, first served basis so please do not delay.

New to us via the Active Network is the request to upload your child’s picture. This feature will allow the counselors the chance to “meet” new campers as well as see how returning campers have grown, making the first day of camp all the more welcoming. It will also help us to personalize information for our medical staff as well.

At one point, you will find a very extensive Active Network waiver that you will be asked to sign. You are waiving your rights to sue them since their role is to help people register for events, facilitate necessary paperwork, and provide payment options. They do not run or have anything to do with the management of the events (in this case camp) themselves. However, since other events and programs involve significantly more or less participant risk, they are covering themselves legally for everything imaginable.

Please note that applying to camp provides a tentative spot for your child, but it doesn't become a confirmed place in camp until all of the paperwork is complete, any questions are resolved, and full payment is received. This is one reason we try to start so early to give everyone time to make plans and get things done. We hope you find this system to be a needed improvement and we thank you for your understanding during this transition.

If you find a discrepancy between due dates for a document, please note that the earlier date is the desired one but things will be accepted until the later date or as early as possible.
