ABOUT ADA CAMP CAREFREE

Our mission is to provide a fun-filled, educational camping experience for children with diabetes that will help them to develop and maintain active, healthy lifestyles.

Our camp is located in New Durham, NH, on the grounds of Lions Camp Pride. We have eight camper cabins that accommodate 15 campers, 3 counselors and a CIT. We offer many activities from which the campers choose to participate, as well as Nutrition and Diabetes Education.

The main goal of the program at ADA Camp Carefree is to allow the campers to feel at ease and "accepted" in a community where having diabetes is the rule, not the exception. The campers learn to understand diabetes and the process of self-management under continuous skilled medical supervision.

CIT Program: Camp Carefree offers a Counselor in Training Program (CIT) for 16-17 year olds. The total cost is \$600, which includes a \$50 non-refundable application fee.

The Camp fee includes 24-hour medical supervision, meals and snacks, housing, supervised program activities and most diabetes supplies.

CARE AT CAMP

Our first priority is the physical and medical safety of your child while they enjoy a traditional camp experience. It is not that of perfecting blood sugar management. Our staff includes:

- Physicians, nurses, and other health care providers who provide round-the-clock medical supervision.
- Registered dietitians who plan meals and snacks, and manage all special dietary needs.
- Program staff trained to deliver fun, safe, and supervised recreational activities and sports.

- Counselors trained to recognize specific diabetes care needs and help kids adapt to the Camp environment.

The American Diabetes Association makes every attempt to accommodate medical and/or emotional needs of campers. However, if we can not meet your child's needs, the American Diabetes Association reserves the right to deny admission to Camp and we will refund your deposit.

The true cost for a camper to attend is \$2400 but families pay only \$1200 per camper. Need help paying for camp? Financial assistance is available, excluding non-refundable deposit.



APPLYING FOR CAMP IS QUICK AND EASY!

APPLY ONLINE

- Step 1: Visit www.diabetes.org/adaCampCarefree and click on "Register for Camp".
- Step 2: Complete the online application. Pay your non-refundable deposit or total camp fee online if you choose. Download and print the Supplemental Camp Application Forms before leaving the site.
- Step 3: Send via U.S. Postal Mail to American Diabetes Association, Beth Rowe, PO Box 342, Newmarket, NH 03857-0342.
- A check or money order for the non-refundable deposit or total camp fee if not paid online.
 - Completed Supplemental Camp Application Forms.
- Step 4: Watch the mail for an information packet from American Diabetes Association Camp Carefree. This application and payment reserves a spot for your child.

APPLY OFFLINE

To begin the offline application process:

- Step 1: Mail the completed Reservation Form in this brochure with the non-refundable deposit of \$50 to Camp Carefree, American Diabetes Association, Beth Rowe, PO Box 342, Newmarket, NH 03857-0342.
- Step 2: Within a few weeks, you will receive a Camp Application packet.
- Step 3: Complete and mail this Camp Application by March 30, 2012 and the remaining fee by June 1, 2012.
- Due to limited space, it's important to mail your complete Camp Application and payments due as soon as possible.

REFUNDS

Refunds are only available for campers who cancel in writing at least 60 days prior to the first day of Camp, or for campers who suffer illness or tragedy. The deposit will not be refunded. Complete refund information will be provided when you register for Camp.
